On the first nose, the aromas of spices, incense and liquorice bring a lot of complexity. Then, it evolves on notes of raspberry, cherry and currant. The attack is characterized by a beautiful presence on the palate. The sweetness and the fruit bring a lot of elegance and length to this wine.

A serious wine, to keep but which will also bring a lot of pleasure from now on.
