### About

Wara Wara means 'far away' in the indigenous language of the Darug people, who were a group of Australian Aborigines that were united by a common language and strong ties of kinship. This fruit-driven and extremely food-friendly range showcases the unique character of this far away land.

These grapes have been selected from vineyards across South Eastern Australia, with the natural variation that occurs between the vineyard sites and soil types. Grapes are machine harvested at night.

### Tasting Notes

This Shiraz is ripe and bold with aromas of blackcurrants, giving way to blackberry and cherry notes on the palate with hints of pepper and liquorice.

For a match made down under, serve at room temperature and pair with grilled burgers.
