

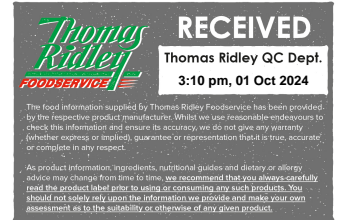

Short Tasting Note: Bright and intense black fruits and smoky pepper.
Long Tasting Note: Stellar have produced another excellent example of a No Added Sulphur wine. This Shiraz has a bright ruby hue in the glass with an inviting black fruit and smoky pepper nose. In the mouth its clean and intense with a purity of character that shows Shiraz at its best.
