#### **Cooking Instructions**

For best results place the burger puck on the hot surface, use a press or flat spatula to press the burger puck into a thin patty. Turn occasionally until no pink colour remains and all juices run clear. Ensure the patty is thoroughly cooked to achieve a core temperature of at least 75°C.

**Caution**: This product contains raw meat. Although every care has been taken to remove bones, some may remain.
